## **Volunteer Opportunity**

### **MEC Bible Distribution for those in Corrections**

We want to make sure that any inmate who wants a Bible to take with them can have one. With the help of IBG and designated donations we gave out around 400 Bibles in 2017.

It would be so nice to have a volunteer who would coordinate the distribution of Bibles. The duties of the MEC volunteer would be as follows

- **Contact the program directors every few months or as needed and find out what the needs of that specific jail are.**
- **Order Bibles in the first week of the month from IGB**
- **Make sure that we have a courier to pick them up**
- **Stamp the Bibles or have another person stamp them (some of our volunteers have stamps already)**
- **Either deliver the Bibles to the correct jails or coordinate with another volunteer who can do so.**
- **Contact the Lifeway stores and see if they have donations for us**
- **When we send out a special appeal in the newsletter or by e-mail (usually 2 times a year) follow-up with those that indicate they can donate. – We do the thank you's to those that donate already as a part of our thank you letters that go out regularly.**
- **Keep in communication so that we can keep records for the ministry**
