



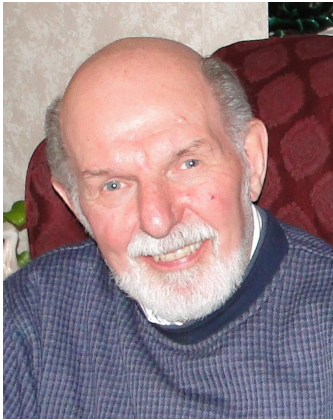

Christ's Conception, Birth & Death Declared



Did you know that major events happened in the stars and the cosmos when Christ was conceived, when he was born and when he died? Understanding what happened in the sky and what happened in the spiritual realm helps me appreciate and celebrate Christ's life, death and resurrection more.

Even more phenomenal is what was accomplished in the spiritual realm in Christ's life, death and resurrection.

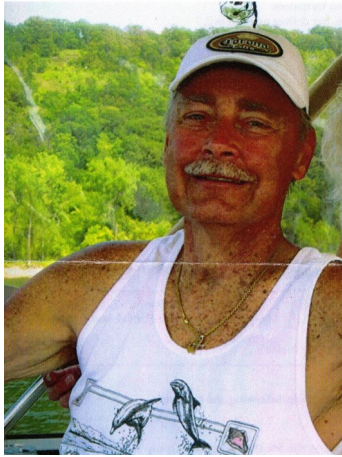
He gave us:

- ◇ Forgiveness of our sins (John 1, Isaiah 53, Hebrews 9)
- ◇ Turned God's wrath into favor (Romans 3, Hebrews 2, I John 1&4)
- ◇ Brought us to God (1Peter 3)
- ◇ Reconciled us with God and other humans (Matthew 18, Romans 5&11, 2Cor. 5, Heb.1, 2&9)
- ◇ Paid the Ransom and brought Redemption from the curse & authority of the law, guilt, punishment and power of sin, (Titus 2, Galatians 4&5)
- ◇ Brought us to God (1Peter 3)
- ◇ Brought righteousness (John 16, Acts 10&17, Romans 1)
- ◇ Imparted Healing. (Isaiah 53 & 1 Peter 2)

In tribute to Roger Anderson, who volunteered with Celebrate Recovery at ACWR. He went to be with the Lord on March 6th, 2014. He was married to



Barbara for 28 years. His children, were Susan (Mike) Nelson & David (Erin) Anderson.

An ex-inmate spoke and said “I don’t know where I would be without Roger. He told me about Christ & He saved me.”

Roger did Alpha and Jail Ministry and was head of men's Ministry and Stevens ministry.

Cody James sang “Amazing Grace” and the whole church and several who were not church attenders joined in singing it.

Barb shared that “Roger had a heart of gold, he was a real servant and the work he accomplished is still going on. After he passed, I found a note in the security box that said ‘a woman's job can be hard when she’s got a man that she’s taking care of. Thank you for taking such good care of me’. There are several people who came to his funeral and said that they were thinking of coming back to church. Another one said, ‘I have to stop thinking about myself and begin thinking about others more’.” Several books have been donated to the ACWR library in memory of Roger.

I taught Bible Study Fellowship for years and enjoyed it, but most there were churched and the gospel touches those who are struggling.

My son has mental health issues and we are planning to start a support group for families with MI issues. Jail has prepared me for that because many of the women we have ministered to, have these issues. I am really thankful to have had this opportunity.”

Diane Johnson taught Parenting classes with MEC and Parenting with Purpose at HCADC for 5 1/2 years.
