MEC Spotlight

Board Member Jeff Hill

Pastor Jeff Hill had a vision over ten years ago that altered the direction of his life. After

struggling with addiction for over 20 years, he finally made the decision to surrender his life to God. In 2004, God put a vision on his heart to create a faith based, Godcentered transitional housing



platform for those recovering from drug and alcohol addictions. He wanted to give back

what was so freely given to

him. Starting with one house and six men, Serenity Village was established

as a safe and private, faith-based "Whole-Way House". Now, ten years later, the transitional housing has grown to eight houses and an apartment community with 85 beds. It has changed the lives of nearly 1,000 men and women in recovery.

In 2012, Pastor Jeff launched Serenity Village Community Church (SVCC). As an ordained pastor, he sought to create a welcoming community that focused on the practical application of sound Biblical principles. The message of the church is simple: To create an environment through love, en-

couragement, fellowship and

Free online Mentor Training

Start Right is a Christian discipleship mentoring tool providing purposeful direction for mentors meeting with their mentees. It was designed for staff to use with students, but is available to anyone who wishes to take it online. It discusses 32 different life impacting topics.
