

Verses For Mother's day

1. Psalm 139:13-14 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
2. Psalm 127:3 Children are a heritage from the LORD, offspring a reward from him.
3. Timothy 5:2 "Treat older women as you would your mother, and treat younger women with all purity as you would your own sisters."
4. 2. Ephesians 6:2-3 "Honor your father and mother" which is the first commandment with a promise "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."
5. 3. Ruth 3:5-6 "I will do whatever you say," Ruth answered. So she went down to the threshing floor and did everything her mother-in-law told her to do."
6. 4. Deuteronomy 5:16 "Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you."
7. John 19:26-27 "When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, "Woman, here is your son," and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home."
8. Luke 2:51 "Then he went down to Nazareth with them and was obedient to them. But his mother treasured all these things in her heart."
9. Psalm 113:9 He settles the childless woman in her home as a happy mother of children. Praise the LORD.
10. Proverbs 6:21-21 My son, keep your father's command and do not forsake your mother's teaching. 21 Bind them always on your heart; fasten them around your neck. 22 When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.
11. Proverbs 23: 22-24 Listen to your father, who gave you life, and do not despise your mother when she is old. 23 Buy the truth and do not sell it— wisdom, instruction and insight as well. 24 The father of a righteous child has great joy; a man who fathers a wise son rejoices in him.
12. Proverbs 189: Whoever robs their father and drives out their mother is a child who brings shame and disgrace. 27 Stop listening to instruction, my son, and you will stray from the words of knowledge.
13. 7. Proverbs 31:26-29 "She opens her mouth with wisdom, and loving instruction is on her tongue. She watches over the ways of her household, and does not eat the bread of idleness. Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her. There are many virtuous and capable women in the world, but you surpass them all!"
14. 8. Song of Solomon 8:2 "I would lead you and bring you to my mother's house she who has taught me. I would give you spiced wine to drink, the nectar of my pomegranates.
15. Proverbs 1:8-9 "Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. 9 They are a garland to grace your head and a chain to adorn your neck.

16. Matthew 15: 4-6 For God said, ‘Honor your father and mother’ and ‘Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death.’ 5 But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is ‘devoted to God,’ 6 they are not to ‘honor their father or mother’ with it. Thus you nullify the word of God for the sake of your tradition.
- 17.9. Proverbs 1:8-9 “Listen, my son, to your father’s instruction, and **don’t reject your mother’s teaching, for they will be a garland of grace on your head and a gold chain around your neck.**”
- 18.10. Proverbs 22:6 “**Start children off on the way they should go,** and even when they are old they will not turn from it.”
19. **You are such a blessing to your mom.** You don’t realize how many hours your mom has prayed for you before and after you were born. Some mothers don’t tell their children I love you as much as they need to, but never underestimate the love that your mom has for you.
- 20.11. Genesis 21:1-3 “**Then the Lord took note of Sarah as He had said, and the Lord did for Sarah as He had promised.** So Sarah conceived and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the appointed time of which God had spoken to him. Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him, whom Sarah bore to him, Isaac.”
- 21.12. 1 Samuel 1:26-28 “Please, my lord,” she said, “as sure as you live, my lord, **I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to the Lord. I prayed for this boy/child, and since the Lord gave me what I asked Him for, I now give the boy to the Lord.** For as long as he lives, he is given to the Lord.” Then he bowed in worship to the Lord there.”
- 22.13. 1 Timothy 2:15 “But **women will be saved through childbearing—if they continue in faith,** love and holiness with propriety.”
23. Titus 2:3-5 “The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not **false accusers,** not given to much wine, teachers of good things; **That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home,** good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.”

These verses show that the same way a mother will take care of her child, God will take care of you. Even if there was a chance where a mother forgot her nursing child God wouldn’t forget you.

24. Isaiah 49:15 “**Can a woman forget her nursing child And have no compassion on the son of her womb?** Even these may forget, but I will not forget you.”
25. Isaiah 66:13 “**As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you;** and you will be comforted over Jerusalem.”
26. Luke 1:46-48 “And Mary said My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior, because **He has looked with favor on the humble condition of His slave. Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed.**”
27. Philippians 1:2-3 Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God **every time I remember you.**”
28. Proverbs 31:25 “**She is clothed with strength and dignity;** she can laugh at the days to come.”

29. Proverbs 23:25 “Let your father and mother have joy, and **let her who gave birth to you rejoice.**”

30. 3 John 1:4 4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.

31. Eph 6: 1-3 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 “Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise— 3 “so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.”

32. 1 Cor. 13 And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

33. Timothy 1:5 “I remember your genuine faith, for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice. And I know that same faith continues strong in you.”

Mothers are not perfect. Just like you have made your mom mad before she has probably made you mad before. We all have fallen short. Thanks be to our Savior Jesus Christ. Just like He has forgiven our sins we are to forgive the sins of others. We are to [let go of the past](#) and hold on to love.

34. 1 Peter 4:8 “Above all, maintain an intense love for each other, since love covers a multitude of sins.”

35. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 “Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not conceited, does not act improperly, is not selfish, is not provoked, and does not keep a record of wrongs. Love finds no joy in unrighteousness but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.”
